**Payment Policy-LPSRA Financial Information**

**LPSRA Generates Income in the following manner:**

Any member who is assigned games through The Association Assignor, or by the CIF Assignor, is required to pay our annual Dues. This fee is determined by the Board of Directors annually. The dues for the 2000-2001 year are \$12.00.

Any member who officiates games that are assigned by The Association Assignor, is required to pay an assignment fee to The Association. The current fees are as follows: \$2.00 for each referee duty, and \$1.00 for each assistant referee duty. These fees are collected by the Treasurer of The Association.

Each member who officiates high school games will be advised of their high school fees prior to the start of the high school season. All fees are included in your high school fees with the exception of any high school tournaments that you may officiate. All high school tournaments are subject to the \$2.00 game fee for a referee and \$1.00 fee for the assistant referee assignment. All high school games are paid by the school and should be paid on the field prior to the start of the game. Any problems with your checks, or if you are not paid at all, direct all questions regarding high school game fees to the CIF Coordinator. The Association Treasurer does not handle any high school monies with the exception of high school tournaments.

**Payment for assignments are as follows:**

Paso Robles Regional Soccer League, Santa Maria men's games and all CYSA league games are paid directly to the officials at the time of their games. Your assignment fees will be collected from you by the Treasurer of The Association.

All other games where the tournament or league pays through The Association, payment will be made at each monthly meeting. Your assignment fees will be deducted from your payment. If you do not attend the monthly meeting, the monies due you will be paid, mailed, on a QUARTERLY BASIS. There are no exceptions to this policy.

The Board of directors will decide which tournaments the Treasurer will attend and will pay immediately at the completion of the tournament. You can be paid on Saturday if you are not officiating on Sunday. All other officials will be paid on Sunday. You will be notified of the venue where the Treasurer will be located. Again, all assignment fees will be deducted from your pay.
